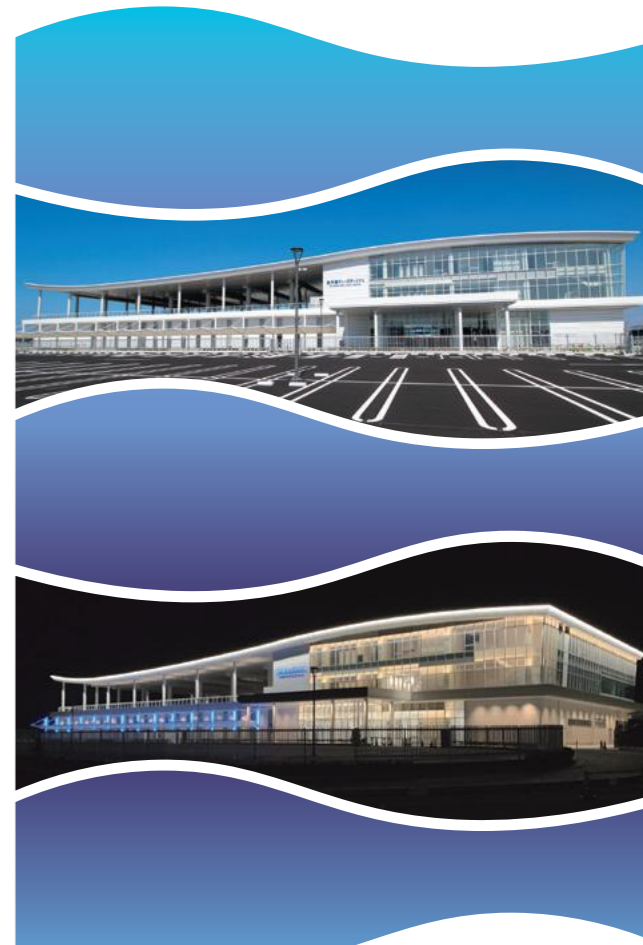

A Whole New Way to Enjoy Kanazawa

A Home Base for Cruises and Creating Liveliness

The Kanazawa Port Cruise Terminal serves as a gateway connecting Kanazawa Port with the sea.

The CIQ and waiting areas are large enough to handle customs, immigration, and quarantine for two cruise ships simultaneously.

The floor-to-ceiling windows offer a stunning view of the Sea of Japan, as well as the lights outside at night.

The Terminal also features the Learning and Experience Room — where simulations let visitors experience what it's like to be at the helm of a cruise ship — as well as a restaurant.

In the cruise ship off-season, the CIQ and waiting areas are transformed into spaces that can be used for events, or where children can play.

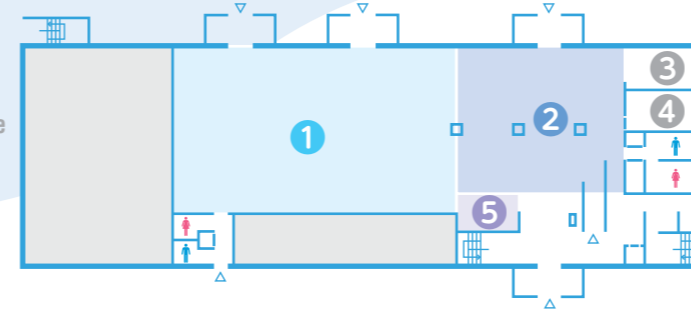


View of the Sea from the Cruise Terminal

1 CIQ Area



Large enough to handle CIQ processing for 4,000 cruise passengers within two hours.

Example Use

This space can also be used for kids' sports events, or other events like business exhibitions.



2 Waiting Area



This area features two pillars decorated with eight spectacular works by leading artisans of iconic Ishikawa crafts such as Kutani Ware, Kaga Yuzen Dyed Silk, and lacquerware from Wajima, Yamanaka, and Kanazawa (made by artisans who are holders of important intangible cultural properties, or "living national treasures," and members of the Japan Art Academy), as well as sixteen smaller Ushikubi Pongee Silk and Kaga Embroidery works, against a backdrop of Kanazawa gold leaf. These pillars stand 1.3 m wide and 4.2 m tall, and display works based on the theme of the sea.

Example Use

This area can be used as a large play space for small children.

5 Tourist Information

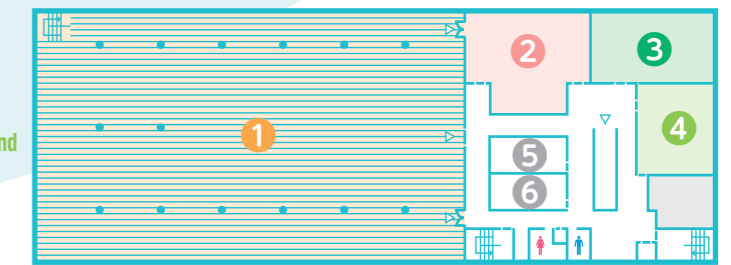


Visitors can find out about nearby destinations and how to get there, as well as events going on.

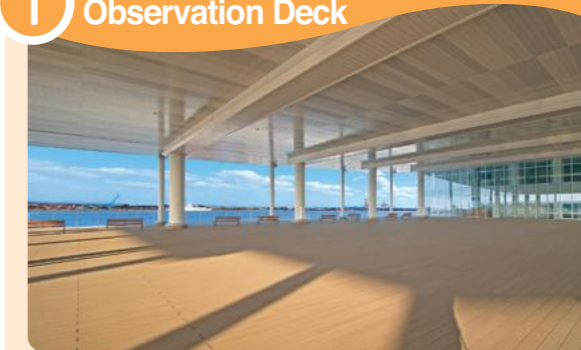

1 Observation Deck



Watch the cruise ships come and go, or see someone off. Can also be used as an event venue.

2 Restaurant Bay Arce



The seating is split into three levels, to ensure a view of the sea from every seat.

3 Seminar Room



This room can serve as a rest area, or as a venue for events like business exhibitions.

Features a large projection screen, and can accommodate up to 120.
